EURESFO 2021 will take place in Malmö, Sweden, on 19-20 October as a hybrid event

In the past 8 years, the European Urban Resilience Forum (EURESFO) has been a unique exchange platform for city representatives, experts and stakeholders from local and regional institutions to discuss strategies, initiatives and actions for adapting to climate change and building urban resilience. The event is an initiative from ICLEI Local Governments for Sustainability and the European Environment Agency (EEA) since 2013.

In 2021, all those seeking to shape a climate-resilient future for our cities and regions are once again invited to take part in the discussion and to meet in Malmö on 19 and 20 October. - Ecosystem restoration and the nexus between biodiversity and climate resilience
- Nature-based solutions for healthy ecosystems
- Local adaptation planning for smaller municipalities
- Low-carbon initiatives and sustainable buildings
- Disaster risk reduction for cultural heritage
